In pursuance of a warrant for 100<sup>d</sup> (directed to be surveyed in three pieces) granted to Thomas Grove, bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1789. And at the request of the present owner Joseph Thompson the same is returned for confirmation the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1811.
