



Situate in Hopewell (formerly Shrewsbury) Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 30th and alluvial soil. Being part of a larger tract of land. Originally surveyed on the 27th day of the 2nd March 1765. by William Matthews late D.S. In pursuance of a warrant for 150th granted to David Griffith dated the 15th day of January A.D. 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land at the request of the owner Jacob Houston on the 18th day of August A.D. 1803. And at his request the above is now returned for confirmation the 18th day of May A.D. 1810
