



In pursuance of an Entry in Warrant Book P. fol. 300. remaining in the Office of the Secretary of the Land Office of Pennsylvania, bearing date the 19th June, 1741. There was resurveyed unto the Widow Lamb, widow of Frederick Gashard, the above described Tract of Land situate on Great Spring Creek, Hidelberg Township, Berks County, on the 10th day of September, 1788. Containing one hundred & forty acres & one hundred & thirty seven perches, & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c, bearing part of a tract formerly granted by warrant of 22^d Nov^d 1736, to Adam Straude, become void by his non-compliance with the conditions &c.
