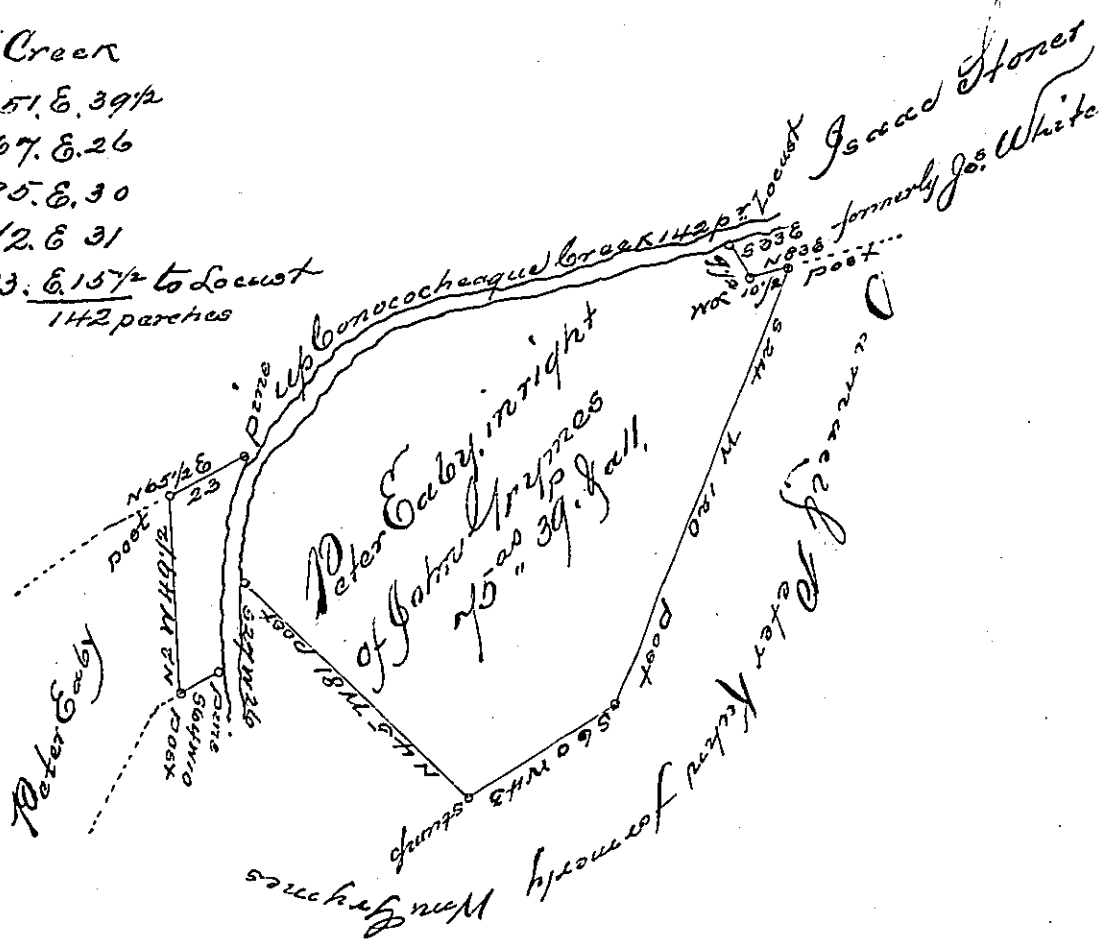

A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Anttrim & Peters Townships Franklin County (formerly Cumberland County) being formerly surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Grymes dated November 10th 1755, but the lines whereof now cannot be ascertained, owing to the surplus in measurement, and the land being principally cleared through with the same appears to run, now resurveyed this 15th day of April 1811, & 61 agreeable to the adjoining surveys, containing seventy five acres and thirty nine perches, and the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads
