



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the ^{second} fifth day
 March 1733. Surveyed unto Christian Kinsey a Tract of land situate in
 Oley in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a tickery a corner of John
 Langis's land thence by Vacant Land North twenty degrees East one hun-
 dred and fifty perches to a White oak, thence by Vacant Land South seventy de-
 grees East one hundred and thirteen perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land
 South twenty degrees West one hundred and fifty perches to a post in the line
 of s^r. Langis's land, thence by the same North seventy degrees West
 one hundred and thirteen perches to the place of Beginning, containing
 one hundred acres with the usual allowance of Sixth Cent.
 Surveyed May 2^d 1734.
