



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 22^d of 8th November
Dom 1737. The above described Tract of Land was surveyed and
laid out for James Swaffer in Robinson Township in the County of Lam-
caster, Beginning at a white oak. Thence North 65 degrees East
by Vacant Land 160 perches to a white oak. Thence North West by Vacant
Land 260 perches to a post. Thence South 65 degrees West by Vacant Land
86 perches to a white oak. Thence south 21 degrees East by Vacant Land
223 perches to a post. Thence south 80 degrees East by the Land of
John Frey, junior 38 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing Two
Hundred acres besides an allowance of Six per cent for Roads.
