



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the sixteenth day of October 1734. Surveyed unto George Haard a tract of Land situated in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a White Oak at a corner of Christian Gatzendeaner's Land. Hence by the same South west one hundred and eighty two perches to a post. Hence by land of Godlie & Herger. North west ninety three perches to a post. Hence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and eighty two perches to a White Oak. Hence by Vacant Land South East ninety three perches to the place of Beginning. Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six per cent. Surveyd^g Oct. 6. 1734. By
