



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situated about one mile northward from Shill's quarter creek in Furber Township, in the County of Northumberland, surveyed in the year 1769, by Wm. Deull, the then Deputy Surveyor of the District & Resurveyed by me agreeable to the old lines on the ninth day of January, 1789, for Francis McBride, in pursuance of his Application, No. 2210, and bearing date the third day of April, 1769, containing Two Hundred & Seventy two acres & one quarter & the allowance of six p. Cent for Roads &c.
