



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 21th day of April 1794. Granted to Isaac Gray was surveyed on the 23^d day of September 1819 the above described tract of Land. Containing 417^{as} 88 perches and allowance of six Per. Cent for Roads & C. and that the same was divided as above stated Between the assignees of the said Isaac Gray, Henry Baldwin 317^{as} 10 ps & John Hagney 100^{as} 78 ps & C. situated in the township of Cassewago Crawford County, and at the time of Making the same John Hagney Was residing thereon, and there was built, a house fit for the habitation of man and there appeared upwards of 20^{as} cleared fenced and in a state of Cultivation.
