



In pursuance of a Warrant for 389<sup>OS</sup> dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1801 was surveyed for Joseph Hackney the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1801. the above described Tract of land containing 389 Acres 141 perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads & C. Situate on the East side of French Creek in Mead Township Crawford County. It being the same Tract of land that was surveyed for the said Joseph Hackney the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1794. In pursuance of his Improvement bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> of September 1793.
