



From papers in the Deputy Surveyors Office of Lycoming County it appears that the above discribed tract of Land was Survey'd by order of J. J. Wallace the then Deputy Surveyor for Isaac Gable on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1791 by virtue of his Warrant Dated 2<sup>d</sup> April 1787. and at the Request of the present owner Andrew Miller Survey'd and Returned this first day of March 1816. Containing two hundred and twenty seven Acres & one hundred perches & allowance of Six per cent for Roads & C. Situated in Washington Township Lycoming (formerly Northumberland) County. and bounded as above discribed. Note the Figure A Represents an Interference with Jasper Ewing Survey on Warrant Dated 8<sup>th</sup> May 1787.
