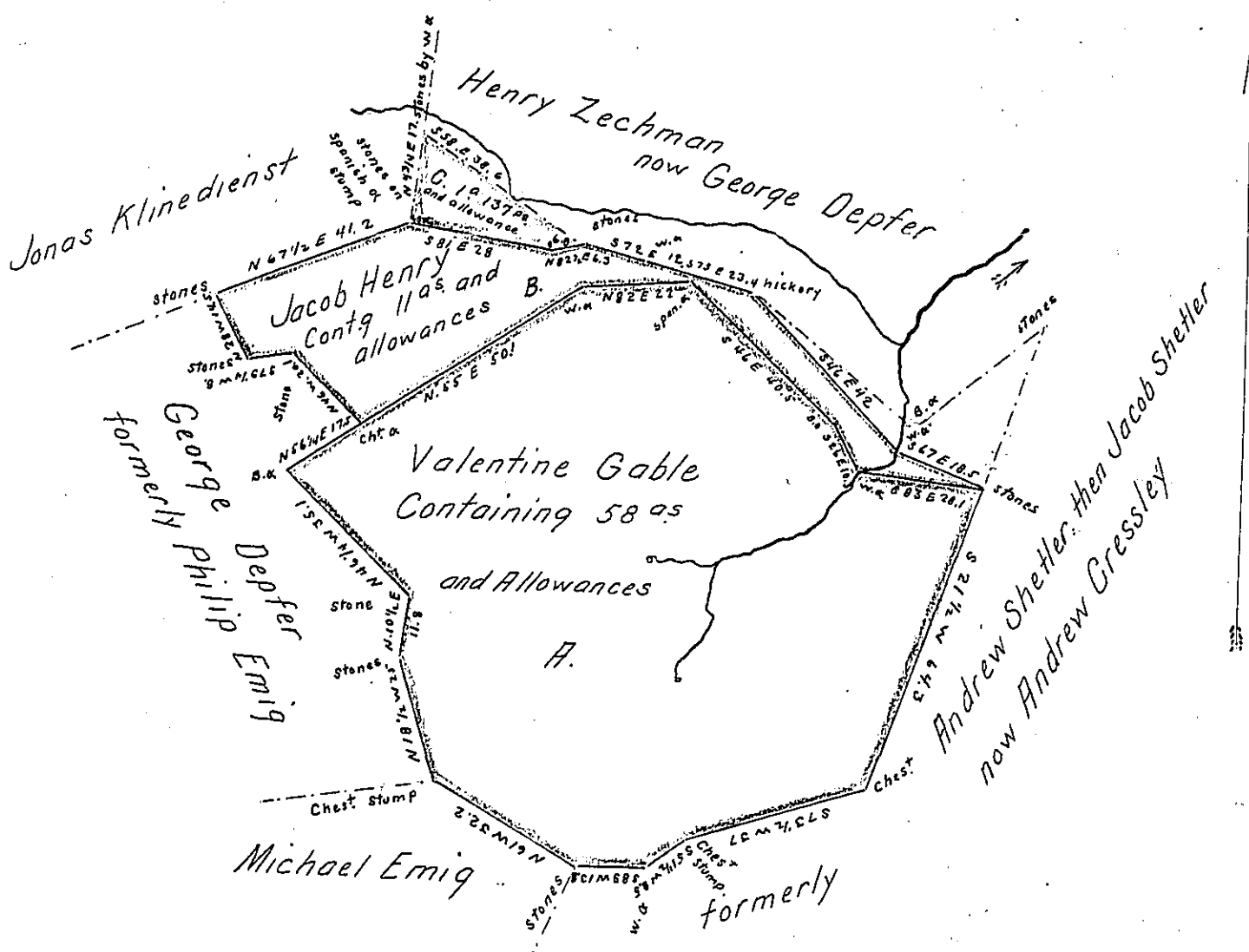

Jur. for 2^{as} and returned in the Surveyors General's Office &c. bearing date the 29th January A.D. 1838.
