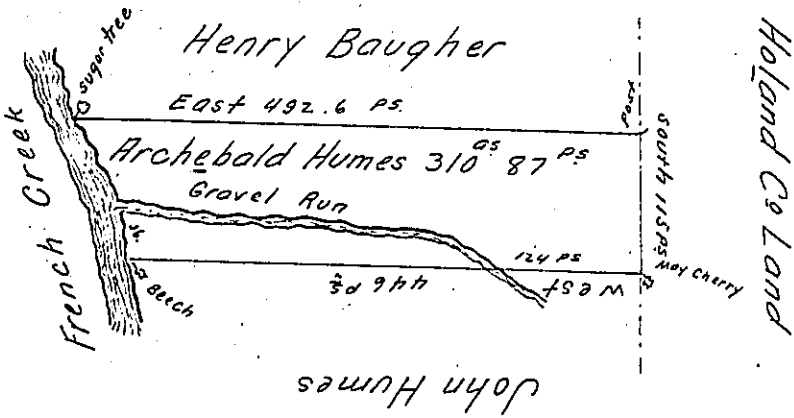

In pursuance of An Order from the Board of property Baring date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1816 was Resurveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1816 for Archibald Humes. - the above discribed tract tract of Land. Containing three hundred ten Acres - Eighty seven perches and Allowance of six per. cent. for Roads &c. situate in Roc dai! Township Crawford County Pa. It being part of a Larger tract which was surveyed on a Warrant for 400<sup>as</sup> of Land dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1801 and it appears in Book A. page 126 Remaning in My office that a survey was made in pursuance of said Warrant on the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of May A. D. 1802. for said Archibald Humes on 441<sup>as</sup> 130<sup>ps</sup> &c. of Land - and the above discribed 310<sup>as</sup> 87<sup>ps</sup> of Land is Clear of the Origenal Interferance with Henry Baugher and at the time of making said Resurvey Archibald Humes was Living on the Land and had a Large and valuable Improvents Grist and saw mill and other buildings and there appeared to be upwards of 40<sup>as</sup> Cleared fenced and under Cultivation.
