



Situated in Hopewell township Bedford County Containing eleven acres and thirty perches and the usual allowance. Being that part of the tract Warranted in the name of John Flock (Fluck) Nov 14th 1805 and not covered by the Patent to Tho^s Buck with the land surveyed on a Warrant to Said Buck June 27th 1806. The Red Dots indicate the lines of the land patented to Tho^s Buck & the Black Dots indicate the lines of the Survey to John Flock, and the Red lines the unpatented part.

Examined and approved for Patenting to Alexander Eichelberger James Price and Ab^m & W^m Fluck the 29th day of April 1874.
