



A Draught of 213@ 113 perches of land Unimproved with allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c. Situate on Beatys Knobb in Armagh Township Mifflin County Penna. Surveyed for E. E. Locke & Co. May 26th and 27th 1852 in pursuance of a Warrant to Peter Fiss & Anthony Boucher for 200@ dated January 27th 1794. This Warrant is for land adjoining Wallis in Beaver Township on the Mifflin County line. At the date of it, the line between Mifflin and Union Counties was supposed to run at or near the place of its location. On the 9th of Oct 1815 Michael M. Monahan made a survey for John Brown for this Warrant and inclosed 588@ 34 perches & allowance. Since that time the timber Stealers and the fire appear to have entirely destroyed the lines which he made. I made diligent search and could not find a Vestige of them. I have located the survey as near the place designed for it as I could ascertain it.
