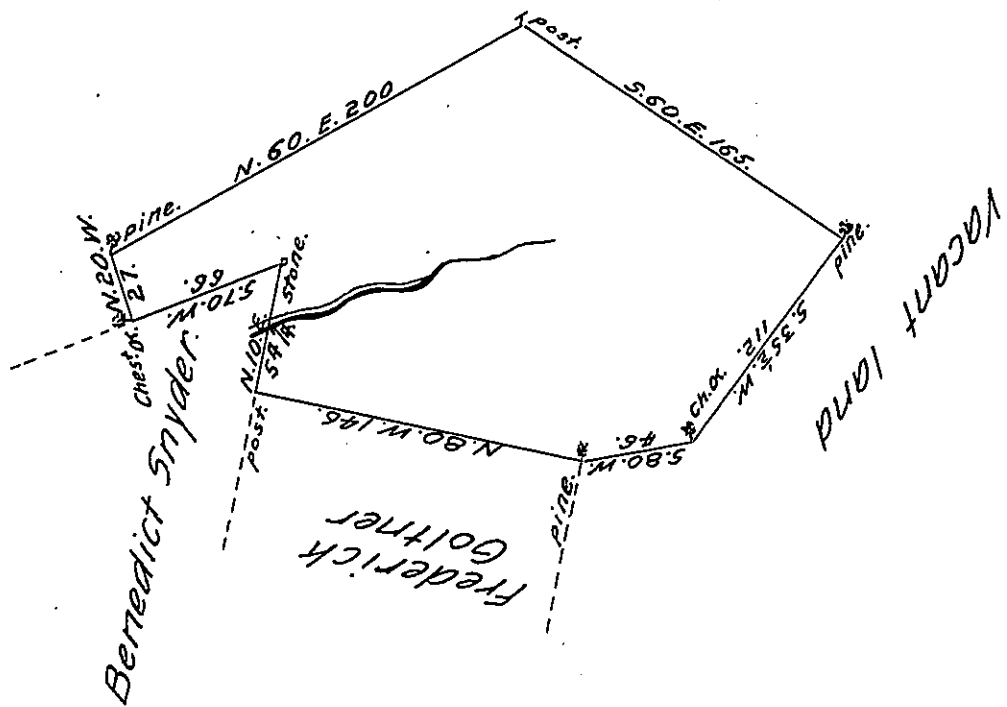


Vacant Land.

Containing One hundred and ninety four Acres-three quarters and the allowance of Six p. Cent &c^a being part of 348 1/2 Acres Surveyed to Frederick Goldner & John Rex.
