The part marked "B" containing 13 <sup>130</sup>/<sub>160</sub> a<sup>s</sup> & allowance, part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to James Griffith dated May 17<sup>th</sup> 1792. The part "C" contg. 24 <sup>60</sup>/<sub>160</sub> a<sup>s</sup> & allowance, part of a tract originally surveyed on warrant to James Griffith dated March 17<sup>th</sup> 1806.
