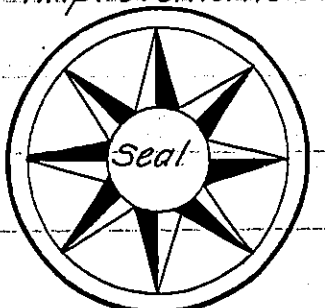


From W. Pine down the Creek to the Hemlock

Situate on the South West Side of Sinnamon Creek about eight miles from the mouth thereof, Grove township Lycoming County New purchase & bounded as above described
