



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing date the ninth day of February Anno 1739 I have surveyed and laid out unto John Curle on a branch of Conewago Creek, in the County of Lancaster on the West side of Susquehanna River in right of Nicholas Curle, one hundred & fifty four (66) acres of land with Allowance of six P^{ts} Cent. signed
