



In pursuance of an act of assembly passed the 12 March 1783 for the sale of certain Lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a commission under the Hand & Seal of office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the state of Pennsylv^a bearing date at Philad^a the 22 Aug^t 1783 The above Tract of land containing Three hun^d and ten acres and allow^e of six Pc for roads &c was surveyed on the 7 July 1785

Returned into the Secretary's office for Matt^w Henderson the 19 Nov^r 1787
