in the Counties of Montgomery, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Francis Hardisty is entitled to four hundred acres of land in the county of Yohogania on the waters of Crabapple Run to include his settlement made in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five. Given under our hands at Redstone old fort the Thirteenth day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Common-wealth
