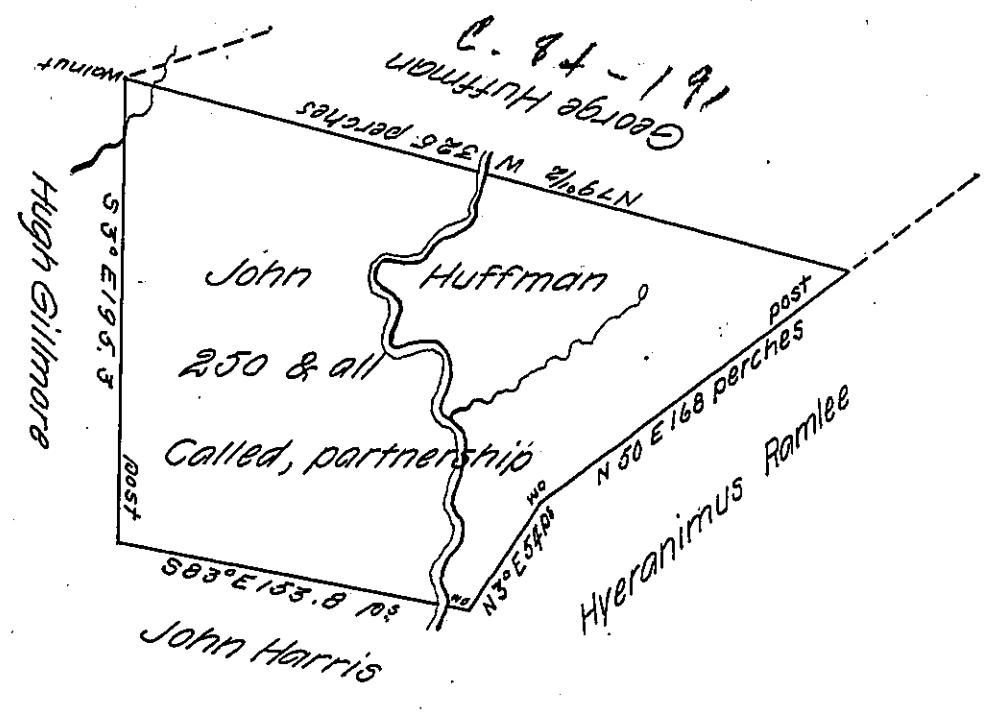


N.B. Hugh Gillmore Caveats the Acceptance of this Survey alleging that Huffman has ran over a conditional line made between them
