

By virtue of a warrant dated the second day of November 1794  
Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1788 to John Andrew in right of John Humes the  
above described tract of land it being part of a larger tract situate in East Hanover  
Township Dauphin (late Lancaster) County Containing 158 acres & 100 perches &  
allowance of six p cent for roads &c
