



Warrant dated the 5th of Feb. 1733.

Surveyed on the 20th day of March 1733, to Jonathan Harben a Tract of land situate in Oley, in the County of Schuylk. Beginning at a post a corner of Jonathan Harben's land, thence by the same North East one hundred & thirty two perches to a post in the line of Elizabeth Bartolet's land, thence by the same South East eight perches to a corner post of the s^d Elizabeth Bartolet's land, thence by the same North East twenty perches to a post, thence South East by Vacant land one hundred & fifteen perches to a post, thence by land of David Gerrard South West one hundred & thirty six perches to a post in the line of Andrew Edges land, thence by the same North West ninety perches to a post, thence by the s^d Edge South West sixteen perches to a corner post of Hans Sniders land, thence by the same North West thirty three perches to the place of Beginning containing one hundred ^{gone} acres with usual allowance.
