By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty-sixth day of February 1733 surveyed unto Samuel High a Tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Phild.<sup>d</sup> Beginning at a post in the line of s.<sup>d</sup> High's other land thence by the same <sup>south west</sup> thirty four perches and the same course by land of Edward Evans one hundred and twenty six perches to an Ash tree corner of s.<sup>d</sup> Evans land thence by Vacant land North West eighty five perches to a post, thence by Vacant land North East one hundred and sixty perches to a Black oak, thence by Vacant land South East eighty five perches to the place of Beginning, containing eighty acres with the usual allowance of six per cent. Surveyed the second of June 1734.
