



By virtue of a Warrant granted to William How requiring the Surveyor General to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed to the said How a certain Tract of Land which (with other land) was surveyed in right of the original purchase of Jacob Fater. And in pursuance of a warrant from the Surveyor General under the seal of his Office, authorizing me to resurvey the said Land, both which warrants are dated the 14th of September A.D. 1764. I have resurveyed unto the said William How the above described Tract of Land situated in the Township of Providence in Philadelphia County containing sixty seven acres and One hundred and fifteen perches without the allowance, this 15th day of March A.D. 1768.
