



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania, containing twelve acres and six perches of Land together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads That was surveyed unto Jacob Howard (at Hoken) By Virtue of order from the Surveyor General dated at Philadelphia on the 13th Day of October Anno-1767 Being Number 2887 granted in pursuance of an Application made by the said Jacob Howard for the same. The said Tract may be called the Squirrels Plain or Squirrels Field Surveyed by order of James Scull Deputy Surveyor on the 14th April Anno-1768.
