



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the South side of High Street, in the Town of York, containing in Breadth on said Street sixty five feet, and in length to a twenty feet alley two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Northward with High Street aforesaid, Westward with a Lot of Ground whereon the Calvinist Church stands, marked on the General Plan of the said Town, No 91, Southward with a twenty feet Alley and Eastward with Bernard Halzinger's Lot, marked on the plan of No 89, entered on the plan of the said Town and Surveyed for the said John Hay, who has built a house on the same according to the conditions of settling the Town,
