By the prop^{rs} sold to Saml Black, who assigned his right to Peter Whiteacre. In pursuance of a Warrant date the 10th of April 1741, reciting a resurvey & division made to Wm Henderson & Saml Black & requiring a Return to be made for their use. Returned the 20th of May 1741.
