



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 2nd day of September, 1738, the above described Tract of Land, Situate on Tobacco Creek in the County of Bucks, Containing in the whole one hundred and ninety one acres and 1/2. Usual Allowance of Six acres for Land for roads, &c. was surveyed the 27th day of October, 1740, by Edward 161. for John Hutchinson
