



Situate in Porter Township Huntingdon County Containing one hundred and seven acres and one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance it being a part of a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Croghan dated the 7th day of July 1762 this part resurveyed and divided from the residue of said tract the 27th day of November A.D. 1851 by the request of Samuel Sprengle the present owner the original survey was said to contain 520 acres & allowance.
