Containing four hundred and twenty acres and one hundred and thirty eight perches with the usual allowance of six P. Cent for roads &c. Surveyed for John Cadwallader Esq<sup>r</sup> the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1794 in Pursuance of a warrant dated 14<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1793.
