



The above draught represents an island in Big Beaver River a branch of the Ohio River, surveyed December 4th 1837 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Benjamin Chew dated May 13th 1837 situate in or immediately below the Falls or Rapid called the "Irish Ripple," in North Sewickley Township, Beaver County Pa. Containing 2 acres 108 perches and allowance of six per cent.
