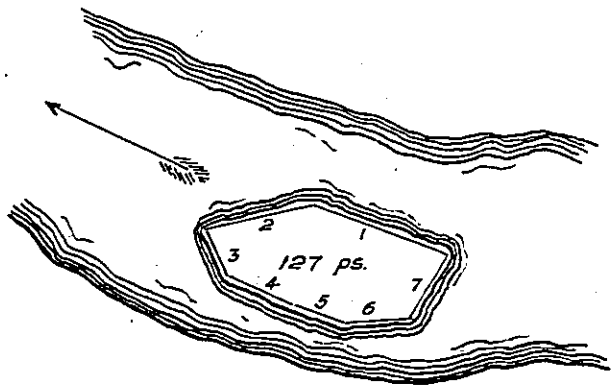

Draft of an island Situate in the Allegheny River in Cornplanter
Township Venango County, known as one of the "Hemlock Islands" and
near the Southern Shore and the Second Island below the one now in
the possession of Mr. Elliott and a short distance below the Mouth of
Hemlock Creek. Containing 127 perches neat measure.

Survey'd 9th May 1847 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Ralph
Clapp dated 4th September A. D. 1845.

I hereby certify the above to be true copy of a survey made
and entered on the books of the office of the County Surveyor of
Venango County.
