By virtue of a warrant dated the 9 May 1750 Surveyed the 19 October 1795 to Jacob

Rhode the above described tract of land situate on a Branch of McMichaels creek formerly in the County of Bucks) now in Hamilton Township in Northampton County containing one hundred and fifteen acres one hundred and thirty perches and the allowance of Six P. Cent &c<sup>a</sup>. The piece marked 20 1/2 acres has been surveyed by application No 1000 & returned for Nich's young. By a draft now produced from Reading it was originally included in Rhodes survey dated 3<sup>d</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup> 1765.
