Surveyed May 21th 1808 by Joseph Snively Jun^r Ass^t of Thomas Kirby Esq late Dep^t Surveyor (as appears by an Official Draught thereof remaining in my office) in pursuance of a warrant granted Samuel Cooper dated Septm^{er} 6th 1792.

Certified this 6th day of March 1810.
