



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town. Number Eighty three. Containing in Breadth North and South on the East side of Broad Way fifty Seven feet six inches and in length East and West two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Broad Way. Northward by Lot Number Eighty four. Eastward by River Alley and Southward by Lot Number Eighty two - Returned into the Secretary's office the 16th day of March 1774 for Adam Heberling by Warrant dated the 14th March Ins.^t
