



A Draught of a Tract of Land Called Birmingham, Situate on the head Waters of Shamokin ^{Creek}, about seventeen miles by estimation from Fort Augusta, and adjoining and between lands surveyed to John Christy & John Clark in Berks County containing three hundred and one acre & thirty eight perches besides the usual allowance of 6 p cent. for roads.
