



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774 I did on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Septem<sup>r</sup>: 1774. Survey and lay out for George Heitle a Lot of Ground Situate at or near the North End of the City of Philadelphia and without the Limits thereof being Number One hundred and Eight. Containing in Breadth on Margareta Street and throughout Twenty feet and in Length on the East side One hundred and Seventeen feet, and on the West side One hundred and Seven feet. Bounded Southward by Margareta Street aforesaid Westward by Lot Number. One hundred and Nine. Northward by Peqq's Run and Eastward by said Heitle's Lot No 107 -

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1774 -
