



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Eighty Seven Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Hurtleberry Street afore said Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Ninety Southward by Billberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Eighty Six. Returned into the Secretary's office the 8th day of Feb. 1775 for Jacob Haverling by Warrant dated the 7th Instant
