



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Hugh Glen on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb^{rs} marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Eighty Six Containing in Breadth ^{North} ~~East~~ and ^{South} ~~West~~ on Broad Way fifty seven feet and a half and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broad Way Northward by Lot Number Eighty five Eastward by River Alley and Southward by Lot Number Eighty Seven. Returned into the Secretary's office the 4th day of April 1776 for Adam Heberling by Warrant dated the same day
