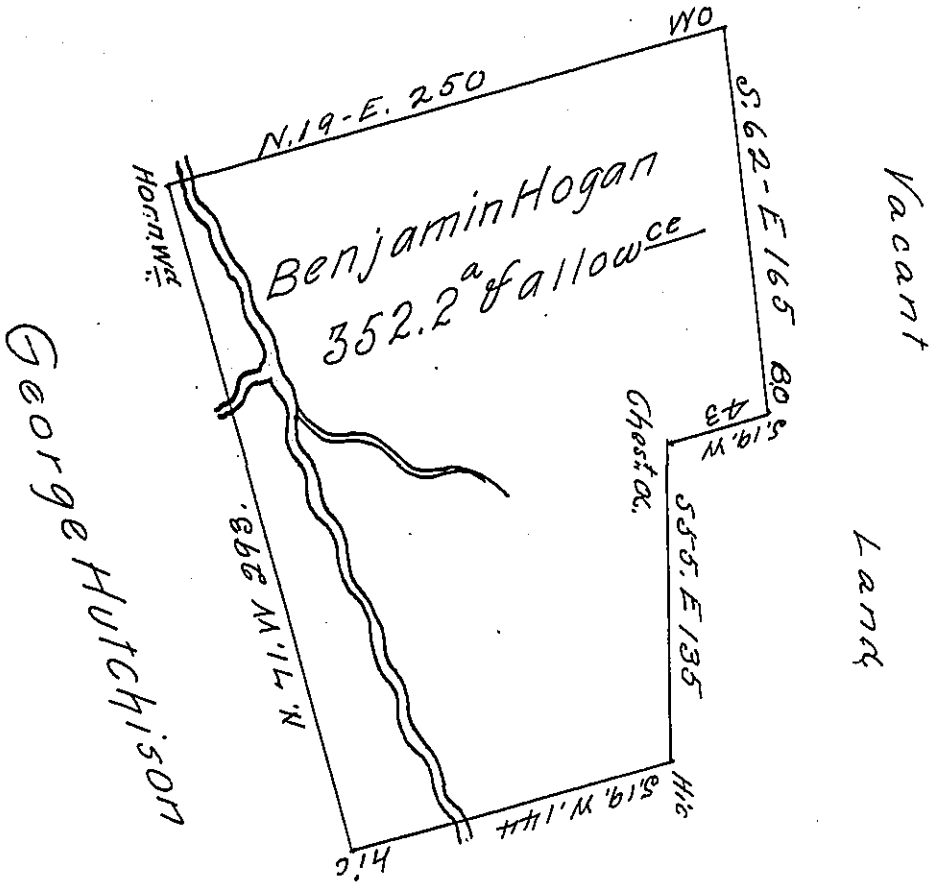


John Gold's Claim



Survey'd to Benjamin Hogan on the 29th Day of May 1776. The above Described Tract of Three hundred fifty two acres & a Quarter of an acre & allowance of Six p. Ct. Situate on a Run emptying into the Allegheny River about a Mile below the old Kittanning Town adjoining Land of John Gold on the West & George Hutchison on the South in Westmorland County.

By Warrant of the 20th Day of February 1775
