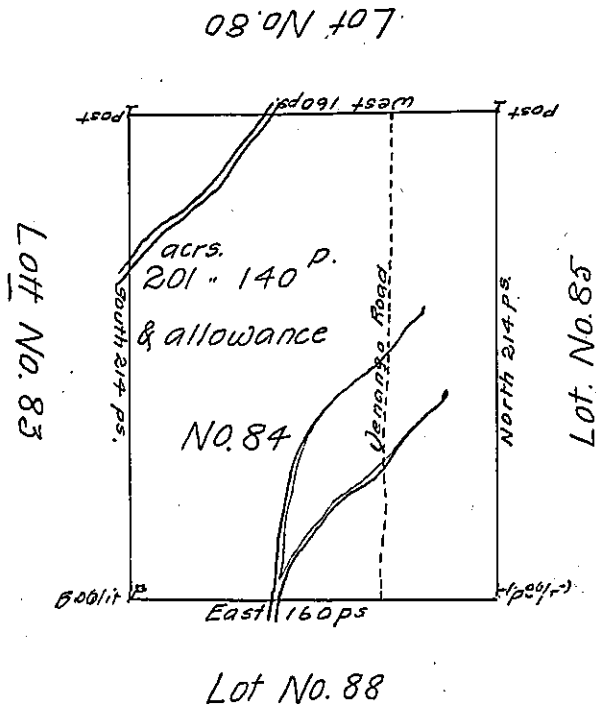

 Land containing two hundred and one Acres one hundred and forty per-
