



A Draught of a Survey situate on the Waters of Ten Mile Creek in Washington County called "Hupps Fragments" containing 180 3/4 acres & the allowance of 6 p Cent, Surveyed March 22 d. 1790. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Everard Hupp for 100 acres Dated 26th Jan'y. 1785.
