



In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the twenty first day of April 1794 granted to Christian Harper was surveyed on the third day of July A. D. 1817. The above described tract of land containing 402 acres 50 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. situated in Followfield township Crawford County and at the time of making the same Sarah ~~Williams~~ <sup>Edwards</sup> was residing thereon and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of ten acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided as above stated, between Joseph Clark and Said Sarah ~~Williams~~ <sup>Edwards</sup>.
