Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> September 1818 to George Huber the above describer Island situate in the River Lehi - about two miles above Bethlehem in the County of Northampton containing One Acre three quarters and the allowance of Six p. Cent &c<sup>a</sup>. Or One Acre and one hundred and thirty six perches (strict measure)
