


Heirs of Thomas R. Kennedy



In Pursuance of Warrant for 400 <sup>acres</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793  
 Granted to Richard Hall was surveyed on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D.  
 1819 the above described tract of land containing 334 <sup>95</sup> 148 perches  
 and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Fairfield  
 Township, Crawford County and at the time of making the same Allen  
 Scroggs was residing thereon and there was built a house fit for  
 the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards of thirty  
 acres of the land cleared and in a state of cultivation.
