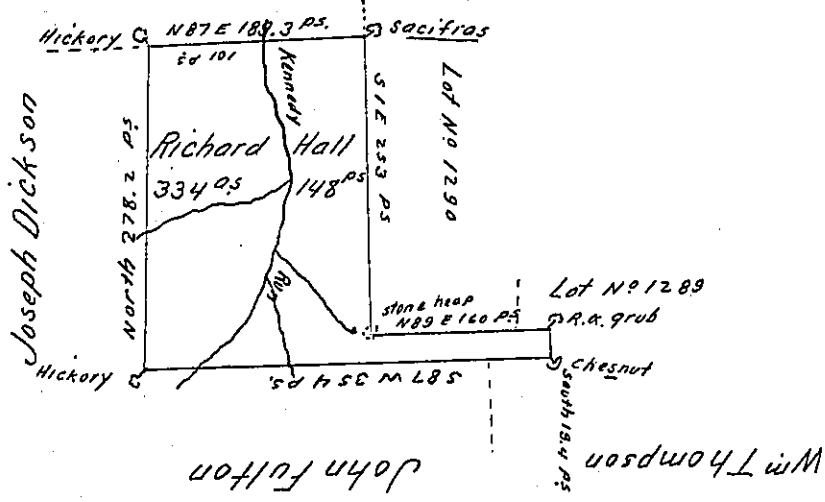


Heirs of Thomas R. Kennedy



In Pursuance of Warrant for 400^{as} dated the 10th day of April 1793
 Granted to Richard Hall was surveyed on the 28th day of April A.D.
 1819 the above discribed tract of land containing 334^{as} 148 perches
 and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Fairfield
 Township Crawford County and at the time of making the same Allen
 Scroggs was residing thereon and there was built a house fit for
 the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards of thirty
 acres of the land cleared and in a state of cultivation.
