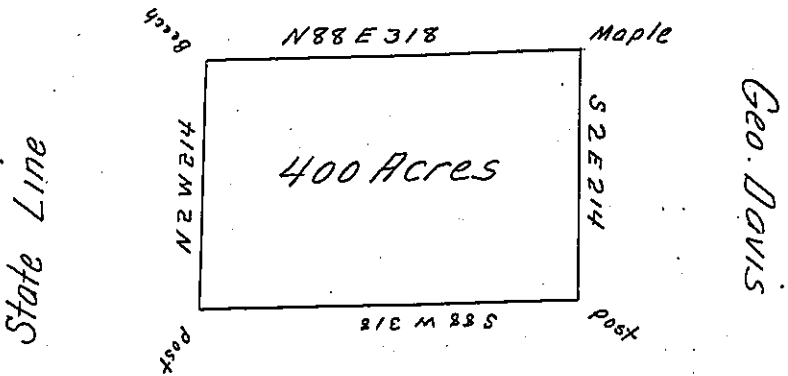


Abram Hunt. Jun.
