of Survey Rec'd September 5<sup>th</sup> 1843. Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Nove-  
ember 1843 to Thomas Jones the above described Tract of Land Situate  
on the Waters of Saw Kill Creek on the Southerly Side of the Pond about  
Six Miles from the Delaware River (formerly in Upper Smithfield Town-  
ship Northampton County) now Dingman Township Pike County Contain-  
ing One hundred & fifty three Acres fifty six perches and Allowance  
of Six p. C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c.
